

Tips and Guidelines for "The SHAC"

1. Directions: Once you exit the Beltway and turn onto Kempwood, follow the Skyline signs to the building (facility name is "The SHAC"). You will see our entrance clearly marked and you can park in any available spots around the building
2. Please park in any available spots, but do not move any barriers from their place. **Do not block any loading ramps that are not designated parking spots or any area is designated for non-volleyball parking. Your vehicle will be towed!** There is a large field that is directly across from the facility, and **weather permitting (if there is no rain)** we will have overflow parking there. **If you are able to park in the field, please do so!** Please park as close as possible to each other as we want to accommodate as many people as possible. Parking is available throughout the office building area.
3. There will be a spectator fee at the door (this will be the case for most-all Lone Star tournaments this year). The cost is \$3 for adults 12 and up, \$2 for children 6 to 12. Children under the age of 6 are free.
4. **You will need to bring folding chairs for the weekend. There will be very limited seating provided but there is plenty of space for your chairs to be set up. To view courts 1 & 2, please sit in the area nearest the cinder block wall. To view courts 3, 4, & 5 please sit in between the courts.**
5. There will be a concession stand open throughout the tournament. We will have breakfast tacos from Taco Cabana, coffee, snack food, water, and gatorade, plus much more.
6. Tents are only permitted in the field across from the facility. They may not take up any concrete parking space or be in the area right in front of the facility (grass or concrete). Please clean up all mess at the end of each day as we have to leave the field clean.
7. There will be no outside food or drink allowed in the building or in the lawn area in front of the building. Players can have water bottles during play.
Absolutely NO GUM!
8. No one is allowed to be on the turf area at any time!
